

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology / EzyMigrate Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice Scholarship 2020

Background

EzyMigrate has very generously offered to pay NZ\$5000 in course fees in the form of a scholarship for a prospective female student of the Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice. The scholarship would be awarded annually, starting in semester 2 2020.

Value

This scholarship of \$5000 will cover the recipient's course fees to complete the Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice (Level 7) course.

Eligibility

To be considered eligible for the scholarship, applicants must provide proof of acceptance as either a full time or part time student in the Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice.

Applicants must be female and 18 years of age or older.

Applicants may be domestic or international students.

Criteria

Applicants must provide:

- Proof of acceptance as a new student onto the (2020) Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice
- Completed application form
- Letter of explanation with supporting evidence which sets out the following:
 - Career goals including why you wish to become a licensed immigration adviser and how this will benefit you and your community
 - Your achievements to date, your personal strengths and any community interests you have
 - Summary of your ability and commitment to succeed in academic study at a tertiary level
 - An indication of personal financial circumstances which show how this scholarship will assist you
- CV/resume with supporting evidence outlining post-secondary education, qualifications, work experience and community involvement

Conditions

In the event the scholarship winner does not successfully complete the qualification, they may be required to re-pay the scholarship grant.

The applicant understands and agrees that in applying for this scholarship, if successful, their name, course selection, and photograph may be used for testimonial, advertising, promotional, or public relations purposes by Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology and EzyMigrate.

Selection Panel

All applications will be considered by a panel comprising of key Toi Ohomai staff including the relevant Academic Leader as well as a representative from EzyMigrate.
