Value

One scholarship worth \$1,500 will be credited towards the recipient's second-year course fees.

Eligibility

The scholarship is open to Toi Ohomai Bachelor of Health, Sport and Human Performance students who are in their first year of study and will be enrolling in the second year of the degree.

Open to New Zealand citizens and permanent residents only.

Criteria

Applicants must provide evidence of a high level of commitment to their sport and recreation studies. The financial needs of each applicant will also be considered.

Conditions

In the event the scholarship winner does not successfully complete the qualification, they may be required to repay the scholarship grant.
